

## Statement on International Women's Day

## 8 March 2025

Today, as the world marks International Women's Day, we honor women's resilience, courage, and invaluable contributions to shaping societies and advancing justice, equality, and peace.

On this occasion, we pay special tribute to Sudanese women, who have long been at the forefront of struggle and transformation. They have not merely witnessed history—they have shaped it, leading movements for justice, democracy, and human rights despite enduring systemic oppression and adversity.

This year's International Women's Day comes amid one of the darkest chapters in Sudan's history. The ongoing war between the Sudanese Armed Forces and the Rapid Support Forces has unleashed unprecedented human suffering, and Sudanese women have borne the heaviest burden.
